

LAPC RESOLUTION 6 - 2010

Adopting the

2035 La Crosse and La Crescent Metropolitan Area Transportation Plan

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Transportation regulations require the development and approval of a long-range transportation plan by the La Crosse Area Planning Committee (LAPC), acting a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, the *2035 La Crosse and La Crescent Metropolitan Area Transportation Plan* supports the development of an integrated intermodal transportation system that facilitates the efficient movement of people and goods; and

WHEREAS, the LAPC recognizes the importance of the development of a comprehensive set of modal performance measures included in the plan; and

WHEREAS, the *2035 La Crosse and La Crescent Metropolitan Area Transportation Plan* includes a comprehensive chapter on environmental review to reduce green house gas emissions and congestion due to vehicle travel; and

WHEREAS, the *2035 La Crosse and La Crescent Metropolitan Area Transportation Plan* provides a framework for the development of short and long-term coordinated transportation projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the LAPC adopts the *2035 La Crosse and La Crescent Metropolitan Area Transportation Plan* as being consistent with metropolitan planning policies.
