The final Planning Work Program will be presented for approval.

4. **Resolution 10 - 2010 Approving the 2011 – 2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) (Action Requested).**

The final 2011 – 2014 TIP will be presented for adoption. The final TIP includes two projects funded since the project list was approved in September:

243-11-018 USH 53 at CTH S Interchange Ramp, Reconstruct; Reconfigure North Bound Off Ramp. Design Obligated in 2010 (\$45,000). Construction not yet programmed.

243-11-019 USH 14, City of La Crosse, Cass Street Mississippi River Bridge B-32-0203, 0300, Bridge Rehab - Maintenance Epoxy Deck Overlay. Design Obligated in 2010 (\$195,000), Construction planned in 2012 (\$1,405,000).

Also included are new Safe Routes to School projects in La Crosse County, City of La Crosse, Village of West Salem, Town of Campbell and Village of Holmen (\$875,442).

The TIP includes projects related to the “North / South Corridor” in La Crosse.

5. **Visioning Process for Minnesota’s Transportation Future.**

Lynne Bly, Senior Transportation Planning Director at Mn/DOT will discuss an upcoming process of developing a new vision for the future of transportation in Minnesota. This will provide guidance for a similar process planned for the LAPC area.

6. **Complete Streets Policies for the LAPC Area.**

The TAC and BPAC are working on a Complete Streets Policy for the LAPC and sample language for policies that could be adopted at the municipal level. An update will be presented.
