243-12-016 USH 53, STH 35 to North County Line. Widen paved shoulders. Design Obligated in 2011, Construction not yet programmed.

243-12-017 Specialized Transportation and Escort - Medical/Non Medical, provided by Western Wisconsin Cares. (\$1,252,069 Federal, \$834,713 State annually)
